CORONAVIRUS CRISIS STUDENTS' SURVEY SUMMARY

An online survey was conducted for all the students of Sri Sharada College, Basrur, Kundapura regarding their opinion on conducting the pending semester examinations and reopening of next academic year. 304 students responded. In the survey, only 26% of the students were in favour of conducting the semester examinations in July/ August 2020. For the question of reopening of next academic year 41% of the students responded with a "yes".

The following is the summary of the suggestions given by the students regarding the conduction of semester examinations and the reopening of the college.

- In the current situation please do not conduct the semester exams.
- Corona cases are more in our district so it is not favourable to reopen the college.
- Please conduct the exams on after September .

- Start the college in 2021.
- Conduct the exams after Covid-19 cases are reduced.
- After reopening of the college conduct classes for atleast 25 days so that we can revise and after that conduct the examinations.
- Conduct exams and reopen college as per Government guidelines.
- Colleges should be reopened after Covid-19 vaccine is available.
- Continue conducting the online classes.
- COVID cases are increasing day by day, so it is better to reopen the college and conduct examinations when the situation is under control.
- COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. So do not reopen our college.
- Degree exam is important for our grade and also for our career. We already prepared for the exam and we used this lockdown holidays very

- effectively. So we want this semester exam. Please conduct the exam as soon as possible and also reopen the next academic year.
- Even if the colleges are reopened public transportation will be inadequate for the students to come to the college.
- Due to long months of lockdown holidays we have lost touch with the syllabus. So we request teachers to take classes after reopen so that we can brush up on the syllabus before attending the exams.
- We believe safety comes before everything else so we are ready to take online interactive class but conducting exam based on that is not a good choice.
- If the situation is under control, you can reopen the college.
- It is not the right time to conduct the exams. Online classes are also affected by poor net connectivity in rural areas.
- It is not the right time to reopen the college as the number of coronavirus cases are increasing day by day. Most of us living with the family and in most of the student's homes grandparents live with them. Hence, for the purposes of public health and safety I recommend you to observe the situation for few more days or a month to take a further decision / action.
