a. Safety and security: Ensuring the safety of female students is a top priority on our college campus. Therefore, the following actions have been taken to promote their safety.

b. 1.1 CCTV Camera

The college maintains 24-hour CCTV surveillance to monitor and deter antisocial activities. This constant observation encourages students and staff to remain vigilant. It helps uphold discipline and provides a sense of security for students and their guardians. Additionally, students are required to wear identity cards at all times to ensure their identification is clear. The institution is dedicated to the overall well-being of its students.

2.1 Mentor Mentee Group
